The Trailing of the Sheep Festival will present its annual fundraiser, this year themed STARRY STARRY NIGHT, on Thursday, August 29, 2024, at 6:00 p.m. at The Argyros Performing Arts Center in Ketchum, Idaho. Guests will enjoy an evening of entertainment, food, drinks, and auctions to support the Trailing of the Sheep Festival's mission to gather, celebrate, present, and preserve the history and cultures of sheepherding in Idaho and the West. The event will bring together community-minded, philanthropic guests to enjoy a cocktail reception with live music by the Wood River Quartet, along with a feast of lamb as well as local, seasonal foods, and a variety of beverages for a festive evening. Guests will also be invited to participate in silent and live auctions, a mystery raffle and more to bring in critical funding to keep the Festival's largest events free and accessible to all this October.

A special part of the evening will feature a performance by renowned live speed artist <u>Revel</u>, who will create an original art piece, upside down, within minutes, that will then be auctioned off to the highest bidder. Revel discovered his unique talent as an upside-down speed painter a decade ago and has been wowing audiences across the United States ever since. He has been featured on TBN, the NFL, the NBA and Toyota commercials.
